



REACH Statement of Compliance

Alloy Steel, Aluminum, and Stainless-Steel Electrical Fittings

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the "Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals" (REACH) entered into force. This Regulation defines specific duties and obligations on companies in the European Union that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or articles. This also may apply to any entity that adopts the REACH regulations in North America.

Under the structure of the Regulation, machined steel components, or other similar electrical products/components manufactured by Edgewater Manufacturing sold by American Fittings Corp. are considered "Articles." By definition, this refers to an object which during production is given a special shape, surface, or design which determines its function to a greater degree than its chemical composition.

Compliance Status

We confirm that products manufactured and sold by AMERICAN FITTINGS (AMFICO) meet all current safety criteria and do not require registration, notification, or communication under REACH protocols:

- SVHC Candidate List: To the best of our knowledge, our products do not contain any of the 253 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), as updated by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) on February 4, 2026, in concentrations above 0.1% w/w (1000 ppm).
- Annex XVII (Restricted Substances): AMFICO products do not contain any substances described in Article 67 and Annex XVII, including the latest amendments as of January 2026 regarding CMR (Carcinogenic, Mutagenic, or Reprotoxic) substances.
- Annex XIV (Authorization List): No substances used in our articles are subject to authorization under the current Annex XIV.
- New CLP Hazard Classes: As of the May 1, 2026 implementation of new hazard classes (EU 2023/707), our products do not contain substances categorized as Endocrine Disruptors (ED), PBT, vPvB, PMT, or vPvM above regulated thresholds.
- PFAS Statement: AMFICO products meet all current requirements for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) under REACH, including specific restrictions in Annex XVII and SVHC communication duties.

Transparency & SCIP Declaration

Since AMFICO products do not contain SVHCs above the 0.1% threshold, they are not subject to mandatory submission to the ECHA SCIP database. We continue to monitor the ECHA Candidate List semi-annually to ensure ongoing compliance for our global partners.
